



Dear Mr. Rogers,

As the school year has ended and summer is upon us, we wanted to touch base and give an end-of-year update of the children in LNFI to let you know what an impact you are making on the lives of hurting children. This is not a request for funds. It is simply an update letter to keep you up to date on all that is going on at LNFI. It was an extremely rewarding year, beginning with cautious hope for these blessed children that culminated into fulfilling positive changes in their lives. In many cases, just seeing a child break into a toothy grin is a huge victory, a sure sign that progress has been made and a life has been touched.

It is important that the kids in LNFI not only strengthened their academics, but their character and interpersonal skills as well. Although it is significant to note that our A/B honor roll went from just four to fifteen students, inroads were made into helping them become better spiritually and mentally. They learned that there are consequences to bullying and ways to curtail their anger. They discovered the true joy of volunteering and giving back to their communities. Each child found out that they could be anything they wanted as long as they stayed in school, a foreign idea before LNFI. From love, patience, and respect came growth and transformation.

We have figured up the results for the 2011-2012 school year and wanted to share them with you:

**Program Results (Quantitative):**

We have found through evaluating school-issued report cards that children who attended on a consistent basis (at least 70% of the time) and participated regularly in the program showed the following results in the 2011-2012 school year:

- 76% of the students earned passing grades.
- 80% of the students earned Satisfactory or Excellent scores in conduct.
- 70% of the students earned passing grades in reading and 87% of the students earned passing grades in English/Language Arts.
- The percentage of students on the AB Honor Roll in English/Language Arts increased from 38% in the first 6 weeks to 54% in the 6<sup>th</sup> six weeks.

**Program Results (Qualitative):**

The following data was collected through anonymous surveys that were conducted:

- 79% of teachers & administrators said they would recommend other schools begin an LNFI program.
- 79% of teachers & administrators said the LNFI program has had a positive impact at their school.
- 97% of the parents said they saw a positive change in the attitude and/or behavior of the children.
- 65% of teachers & administrators said they saw a positive change in these areas.


- 97% of parents said they felt there was a need for a program like LNFI at their child's school.
- 87% of parents feel that LNFI has helped improve their child's reading.
- 64% of students said they feel more confident reading since attending LNFI.
- 75% of students said they feel like a stronger person since attending LNFI.

We also wanted you to note: LNFI takes great pride in providing the best possible program for the children we serve. We take our surveys and results into great consideration each year. While these are not bad results, some of them are not as positive as we wish them to be. LNFI is taking steps in the coming school year to improve our programs and better serve our children. We are looking forward to a wonderful 2012-2013 school year!

The LNFI students were also blessed with field trips and other special activities this school year. One of the fundamental missions of LNFI is to introduce the kids to people and activities that will have a positive influence on their lives. Thanks to such partners as the Fort Worth Naval Air Station, the DEA Aviation Division, BNSF, and many others, the children were able to go on field trips designed to educate them about the world around them and how they can make a positive impact if they keep doing the right thing.

It is because of you that the lives of so many children were changed again this year. Thank you for your continued dedication to our children! God bless you.
